What information is collected

This may include:

How your information is stored

The lawful basis for processing your data includes the provision of healthcare, compliance with legal obligations, and legitimate clinical interests.

All records are securely stored using Semble, a GDPR-compliant clinical system.

I also use Heidi AI, a clinical support tool that assists with documentation and report writing. This supports accuracy and efficiency while maintaining strict confidentiality standards.

How your information is used

Your information is used to:

- Provide assessment, diagnosis, and treatment
- Communicate with you about your care
- Ensure safe prescribing and monitoring
- Maintain accurate clinical records

Confidentiality

Your information will not be shared without your consent, except where:

- There is a risk of harm to yourself or others
- There is a legal obligation to disclose information

Data sharing

Where relevant, information may be shared with:

- Your GP (with your consent)
- Other healthcare professionals involved in your care
- Pharmacies (for prescriptions)

Data retention

Records are stored securely and retained in accordance with UK medical record-keeping guidelines.

- Request restriction of processing where appropriate
